


MISSION

- Collection and dissemination of information related to the Internet and internetworking, including histories and archives;




ISOC-ID STRUCTURE












3. Non-ISP License


IDNIC Status

Background

- APJII-ID already be Confederation of APNIC for Indonesia
- APJII-ID policies accept ISP as their member
- ISOC-ID policies accept all Information-internet community inspirations from Internet Industries Provider, Commercial, Banking, Military and Government of Indonesia, which have mandatory for :
 - Indonesian Internet eXchange Network Access Point [IIX-NAP] for Internet eXchange Project
 - National Internet Registry [NIR] for Domain Registration [ID-TLD] and IP & AS Registration [IDNIC].
 - National Public Key Infrastructure [N-PKI] for National Certification Authorization


The Process

- ISOC-ID Submission for IDNIC at APNIC Meeting in Taiwan [PAST]
- Integration APJII-ID into ISOC-ID as the Confederation for Internet Service Provider IP & AS Registration. [PRESENT]
- Implementing IDNIC as National Internet Registry, member of APNIC. [FUTURE]



GovNIC and MilNIC

- **Awareness** for data [information], logical and physical securities on Government and Military Internet or Network
- All Government and Military Offices are banned to use Commercial ISPs including IP Addresses & Ass
- Government Internet eXchange [GIX] and Military Internet eXchange [MIX] for internal interconnection government network.
- Government Network [GovNET] and Military Network [MilNET] Administrator from Governance and Military people.





CONCLUSION

- ISOC-ID is a **neutral body** that serves & facilitates public demand on Information Internet Facilities. ISOC-ID will keep develop about ID-TLD and IDNIC policy, such as Registry DB, Fee Structure, Membership policy and many more, with some input from other APNIC NIR Members.
- The Internet Society [ISOC] has **strongly supported IDNIC & ID-TLD Program** as the best hope a nongovernmental approach to Internet governance. The future of IDNIC & ID-TLD depends on its ability to develop international support for its programs and to build a stable financial base. The sometimes conflicting interests of governments, of the operators of the country code top-level domains, and of various nongovernmental parties cannot be resolved without serious attention to a variety of public policy issues. These include questions about the primacy of public interest versus commercial interests, the continuing role of the Internet Society, and the continuing conflict between the needs of trademark owners and the interests of Internet users in expanding the domain name space.
- **ISOC-ID** will support public policy such as Access, Censorship, Children and the internet, Copyright, Digital divide, Domain Name Systems, E-Commerce, Encryption, Privacy, Security, Societal, Spamming, Woman and the internet, and others public policy.
