
MISSION

- Collection and dissemination of information related to the Internet and internetworking, including histories and archives;






ISOC-ID STRUCTURE







Existing FO Traffic to IIX1 & IIX2




IIX 1 – 100Mbps F0 Traffic (source <u>anto.daryanto@kabelvision.com</u> - 4 march 2002)


