•Registration Services are based on Sao Paulo Brazil.








# **IPv4 DISTRIBUTION PER COUNTRY**






### IPv4 /24 ALLOCATED PER MONTH






# **IPv4 ALLOCATIONS PER MONTH**






# **ASN DISTRIBUTION PER COUNTRY**



### Total amount 814 ASN




### **ASN ASSIGNMENT PER MONTH**





# **IPv6 ALLOCATION IN LACNIC**




### 9 IPv6 allocations
