What is Euro-IX?

- Euro-IX = European Internet Exchange Association
- Formed in May 2001
- Established with three main objectives in mind:
 - 1. To act as a portal for organizations looking to join an IXP
 - 2. To educate the general community
 - To provide a platform for IXPs to exchange information and come together to resolve common industry related issues
- As Euro-IX evolved the last of the three objectives seemed to take priority
- As of the 1st of January 2005 our membership agreed to invited IXPs from around the world to join Euro-IX
- Euro-IX is <u>NOT</u> an Internet Exchange Point!

Some current statistics (1)


- 37 Affiliated IXPs in 23 countries on 3 continents
- Total aggregated peak traffic of European member IXPs is just over <u>500Gbps</u> and rising
 - was 272Gbps February 2005 (84% increase in 12 months)
 - 7.2% increase in traffic over last month
 - 'Average' European IXP peak traffic is 17.9Gbps (with one IXP now peaking at over 135Gbps)
- 16 European member IXPs are now offering 10GE port services


Some more statistics (2)

- Total membership customer base is 2.411 connectees with 1.426 unique ASNs
- Average of 260Mbps peak traffic per customer
- Average cost for a 1GE port in Europe is:
 850 EUR / 1.350 AU\$ / 1.000 US\$ per month (this is exclusive of housing and transit costs)


Make up of our membership
