Fee Structure Options – Components

- Activity plan and adopted expense budget
- Currency in which the fees are to be charged
- Escalation process for review of fees
- Application fees
- Memberships tiers/classes
- Per address fee for NIRs
- Discount for NIRs based on 'other' work undertaken
- Link to address space 2 bites for IPv4; 4 bits for IPv6
- Service intensity
- Continuous formula as basis for charging of fees total address holding, not membership based
- LDCs discounts to apply to LDCs
- Ageing of address holdings

Fee Structure Options – Prerequisites

- The following elements have been identified as pre-requisites for all options under consideration:
 - All members fees should be charged in AUD to help manage the deteriorating exchange rate and taking into account the expenses being paid in AUD
 - 2. Budgets should be set according to an activity plan which is to be costed up and shared with the EC

Undertake member surveys to define needs of and services sought by members

Endorsement of survey findings by the EC

Develop an activity plan incorporating the services required by members

Set budget in accordance with services outlined In activity plan

Set fees at levels sufficient to fund services set out in activity plan and budget

KPMG will develop a number of long-term member fee structure solutions should the EC commission part B of this project

Definitions of Components for APNIC Fee Structure Options	
Component	Definition
EC Endorsement Members Survey	Member surveys to be undertaken at regular intervals with findings to be endorsed by the EC
Activity Plan Preparation	 Activity plan should set out all services to be provided to members. Budgets should be set according this plan which is to be costed up and shared with / endorsed by the EC
Escalation Process for Review of Fees	Clear and transparent approach for ongoing review of APNIC membership fees
Application Fees	Membership joining fees for new members
Per Address Fees for NIRs	One-off per address fee for each address allocation
Using Existing Membership Tiers	Current membership tiers: extra large, very large, large, medium, small, very small, associate
Additional new Membership Tiers - Lower Entry Level Fees	Introduction of additional lower level membership tiers
Fees charged in AUD	Fess to be levied in AUD as opposed to USD to minimise impact of exchange rate fluctuations
Set a maximum fee increase cap	Maximum level / percentage by which fees can be increased per annum
Service "Intensity"	Maximum level of certain requests included in membership
Ageing of Address Holdings	IPv4 address runout – provide discounts for IPv6 addresses to encourage uptake
Give discounts for NIRs	Discount for NIRs when compared to direct APNIC members
Give discounts for LDCs	Discount for members located in LDCs
