#### APNIC policy implementation update

- prop-033: End site assignment policy for IPv6 (including prop-031)
- prop-035: IPv6 portable assignment for multihoming
- prop-032: Four-byte ASNs

#### prop-032: Four-byte ASNs

- 1 January 2007
  - APNIC delegates 4-byte AS numbers when requested.
  - Else, a 2-byte only AS number will be allocated by default.
- 1 January 2009
  - APNIC delegates 2-byte only AS numbers when requested.
  - Else, a 4-byte only AS number will be allocated by default.
- 1 January 2010
  - No distinction between 2-byte and 4-byte AS numbers.
- Assigned 2 and allocated 10



# prop-33: End site assignment policy for IPv6 (including prop-031)

- prop-031
  - -Amend the IPv6 HD ratio from 0.8 to 0.94
- prop-033
  - Remove the minimum assignment size of /48 for an end site
    - If only one subnet is anticipated for an end site, the minimum assignment size should be /64
  - Utilisation of IPv6 address space measured on /56 boundary.
- Implemented 9 March 2007



# prop-035: IPv6 portable assignment for multihoming

- Allows end sites that currently multihome or plan to multihome to receive a portable assignment of minimum /48
- Implemented 9 March 2007
- Assigned 3 (1\*/47 & 2\*/48)
