# APNIC fee vote

- Voting open to APNIC members only
- Proposal: member-2007-01



# Voting methods

- Only registered voting contacts for APNIC members can vote:
  - Online via MyAPNIC
    - started 9:00am UTC+5.30 on Mon, 27 Aug
    - ended 9:00am UTC+5.30 on Wed, 5 Sep
  - Appoint a proxy
    - In accordance with APNIC By-laws
  - Onsite at members meeting
    - collect your ballot papers from meeting registration desk
    - Open now till 2pm today

# New ballot paper for onsite voting

- To make the vote count easier
- Different ballot paper for each tier of membership
- Ballot paper is worth number of votes your membership tier entitles you to
  - Associate: 1 votes
  - Very Small: 2 votes
  - Small: 4 votes
  - Medium: 8 votes
  - Large: 16 votes
  - Very Large: 32 votes
  - Extra Large: 64 votes
- For members who wish to split their vote, you can "trade in" their ballot paper for a set of single-vote papers equal to your total voting entitlement
