- Extend RPSL to support IPv6 routing policies
- Include necessary functionality available in the 6Bone registry adapting it to RPSL

28 January 2003

Requirements and considerations

- Backwards compatibility with current RPSL
- Clear and concise non-ambiguous syntax (humans and machines)
- Minimise duplication of information
