# ASO Address Council

- MoU signed between the NRO and ICANN
- IPv4 Global Policy submitted through RIRs to Address Council to ICANN
  - Awaiting action by the ICANN Board
- Transition to new Address Council
  - And new Secretariat

# ASO Address Council

- **Address Council – AC**
  - Does not represent the RIRs directly
  - Three representatives from each RIR Region
  - Not necessarily RIR members
  - ALL interested parties may participate

# Effect of NRO on AC

- Impact of NRO on the AC
  - The Address Council is now
    - The NRO Number Council
  - Numbers Council is similar to the AC
    - RIR Board of Director elects one
    - Communities elect two
  - Transition is currently underway
