## Deprecation of ip6.int

- ip6.int deprecation project report
  - Sanjaya, APNIC (15min)
  - RIRs agreed to coordinate as a global activity
  - The cutoff date is 1 June 2006; not final but firm
  - Schedule (announcement, notify root ip6.int)
- Technical consideration on deprecation of ip6.int
  - Kazu Yamamoto, IIJ (15min)
  - The WIDE project expects no fatal thing will happen
  - Quality of reverse mapping would be better
  - If a server is running with "ip6.int only" resolver, side effects would happen. But rare and not fatal
