Review Phase

- (2005-08) Proposal to Amend the IPv6 Assignment and Utilisation Requirement Policy

Last Call

- (2005-12) 4-byte (32-bit) AS Numbers
- (2005-02) IP assignments for Anycasting DNS



ENUM Update

- RIPE NCC acting as Tier-0 registry
 - On request from IAB
- 7 delegations in last 6 months
- No requests objected by the ITU-T TSB
- IPv6 glue supported in the RIPE database
- Improved DNS quality checking


Corporate Governance

 - Average fee decrease 9%
 - EUR 2.5 M rebate to existing members
