

 - Not an End Site;

 - Plan to aggregate

 - -2 Some block to be left
 - 3 Keeping current practices until the last mement
 - 4 Separate discussions on recycle issue

prop-037: Deprecation of email updates for APNIC Figist (x) and whois data (Terry Manderson)

- The proposal
 - Secretariat to phase out email updates of registry and whois data in favour of more suitable and responsible methods providing APNIC has bridging mechanism provide migration capability
