
RIR Income and Expense 2005

	AfriNIC	LACNIC	APNIC	ARIN	RIPE NCC
Revenue	769,641	1,016,731	5,823,736	10,531,681	15,074,201
Expenses	419,732	844,841	5,509,442	7,590,880	11,731,574
Net Income	349,909	171,890	314,294	2,940,801	3,342,627

- *APNIC a bit more than half the income of ARIN
- *APNIC a bit more than 1/3 income of RIPE/NCC
- *But APNIC does about the same work!


Measured "Work Product" IPv4 Allocations RIRs to LIRs/ISPs

From "Internet Number Resource Status Report" 2006.09.30




- *RIPE and APNIC about the same

Cost of Work Product - 2005


