

Responsibilities -- Who Decides What?

- Resource Policies Not RIPE NCC Territory
 - Solely decided by the open RIPE Community
 - Clearly defined Policy Development Process
- Activity Plan & Budget
 - Yearly cycle
 - Drafted & published by RIPE NCC
 - In preparation of General Meeting
 - Decided (& possibly amended) by Executive Board
- Charging Scheme
 - Yearly cycle
 - Drafted & published by RIPE NCC
 - Decided by General Meeting

Charging -- The History

- "Contributors"
 - Self declared size & contribution
- Change to Membership Organisation
 - Three Membership Classes: Small, Medium, Large
 - Three matching membership fees
 - Yearly calculations of size determined by resource holdings over time
 - Class boundaries decided by "magical gaps" in size distribution

Charging Scheme today

- Five Membership Classes
 - XS, S, M, L, XL
- A Priori Definition of Size of Membership Classes
 - 20%, 55%, 20%, 4%, 1% from XS to XL
 - Use algorithm to position members relative to each other sorted by size
- Evolution of Charging Algorithm over time
