  - Resource Certificate Trial Service



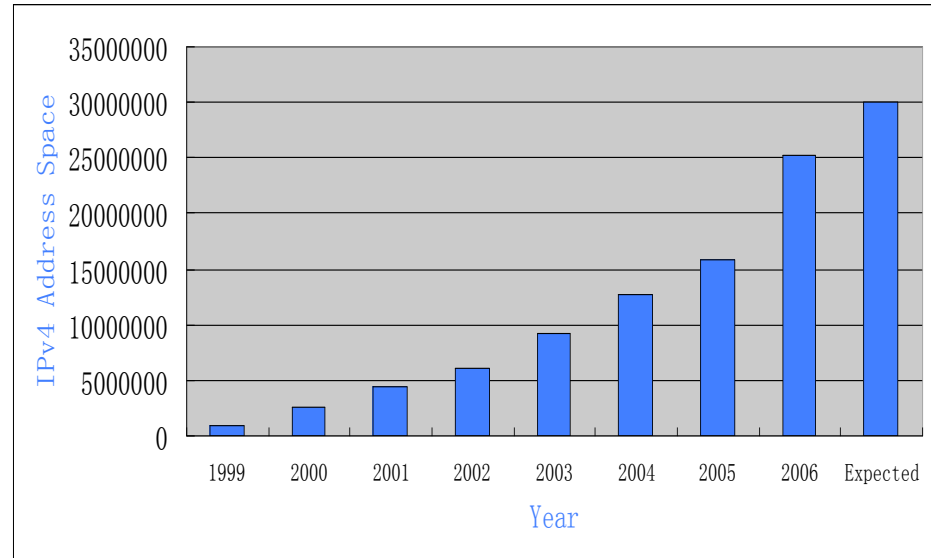
# TWNIC Update
